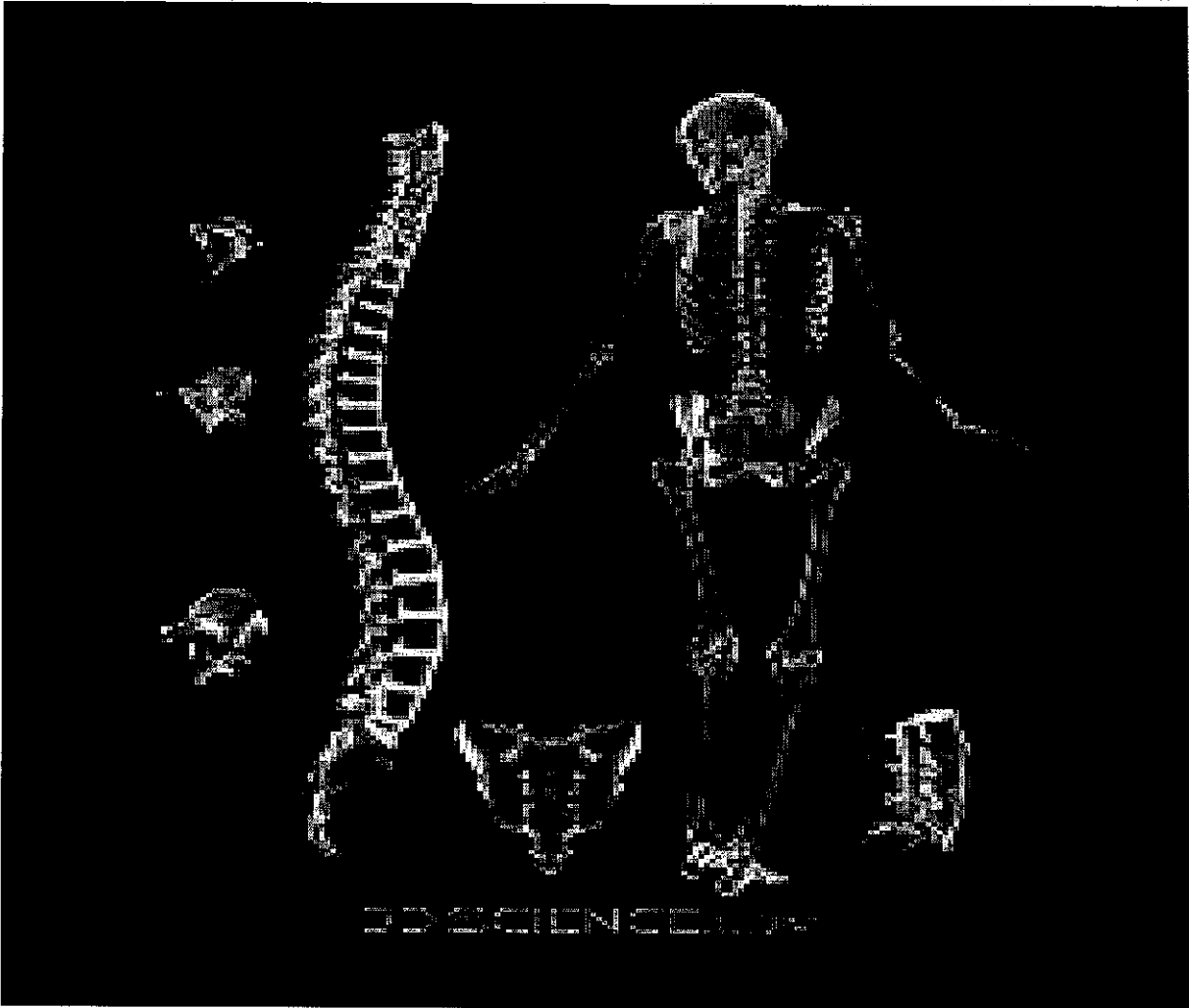


# The Axial Skeleton Family Tree

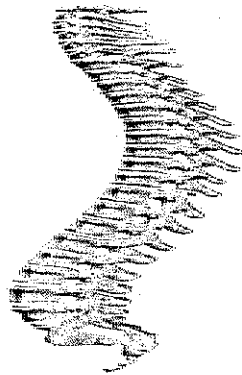
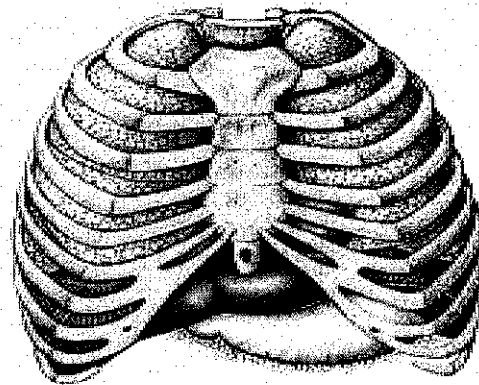
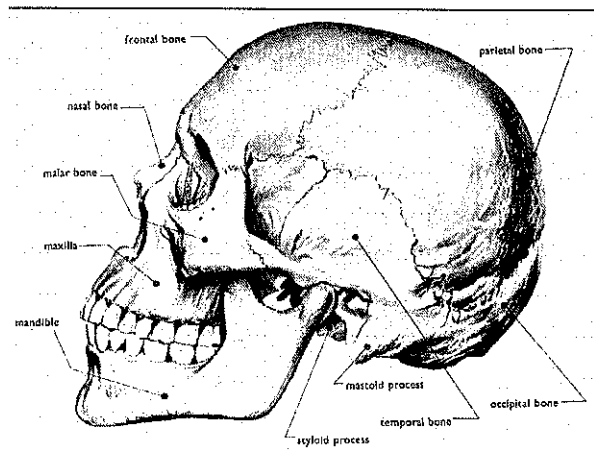

Axial is made up of 80 bones, these bones are made from her children.

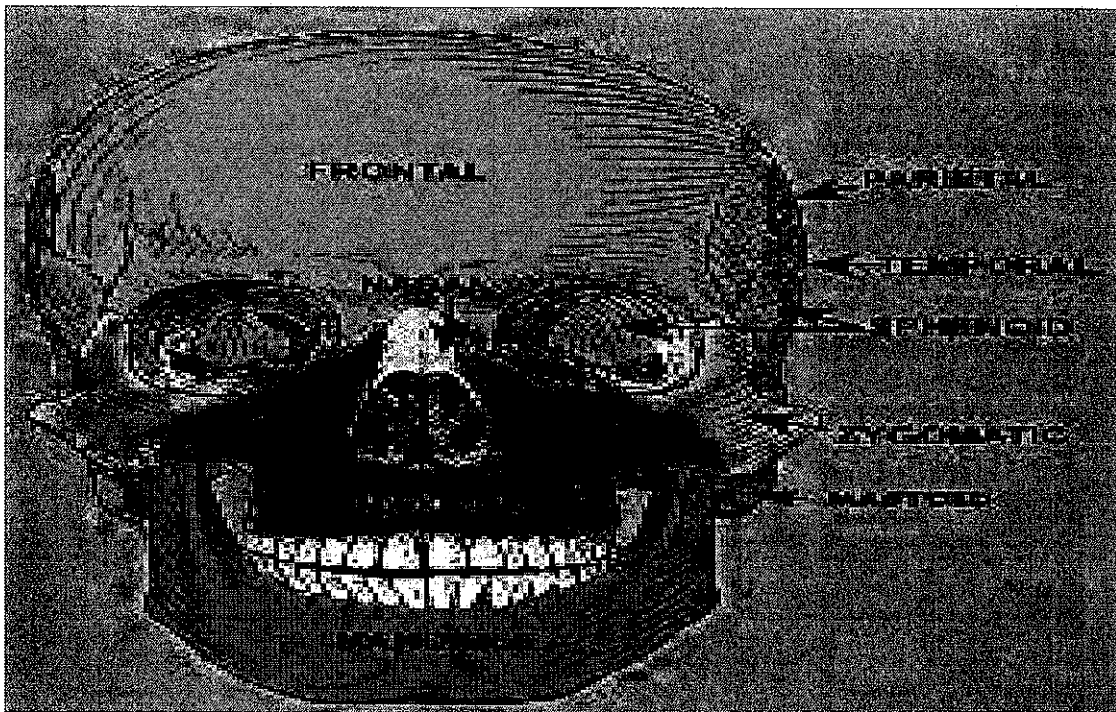


The oldest child is skull, but her family mostly calls her cranium.

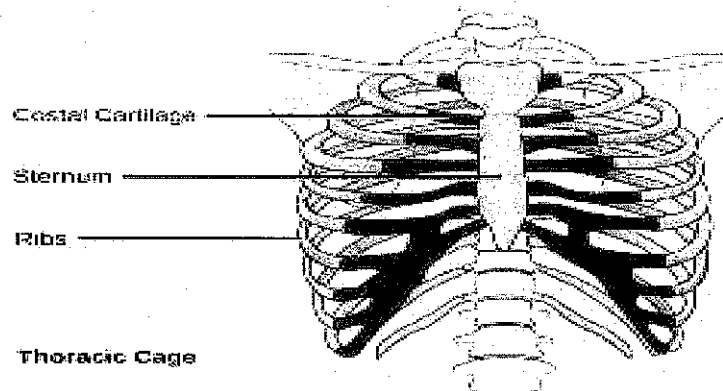
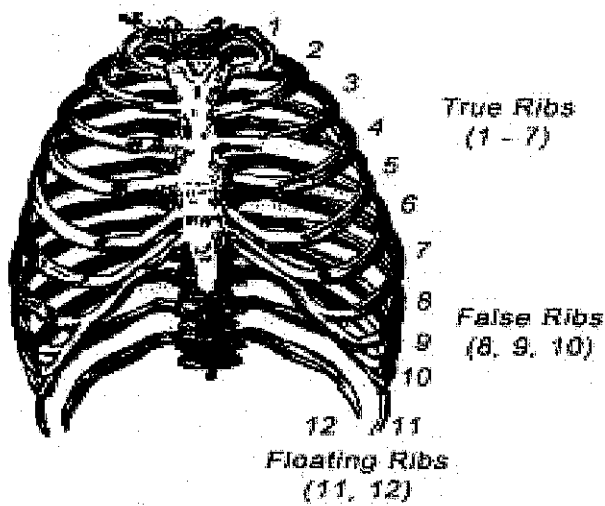
Skull has nine other kids.

maxilla are the other seven kids.

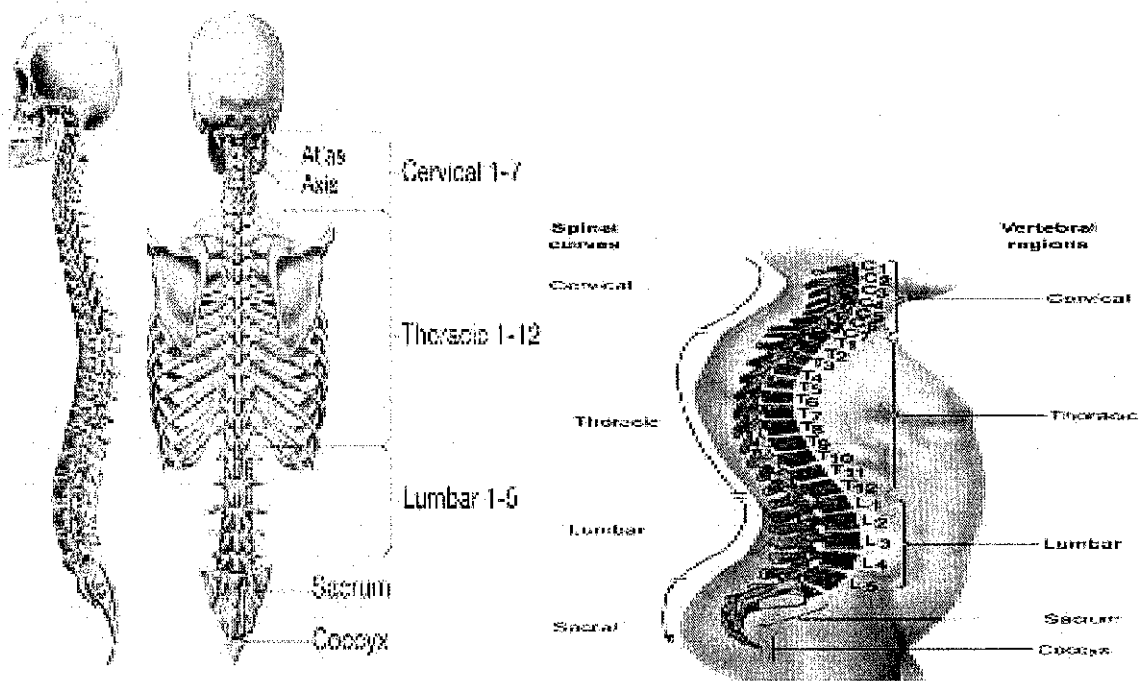
Here is a picture of how their rooms are located inside of skull's home.

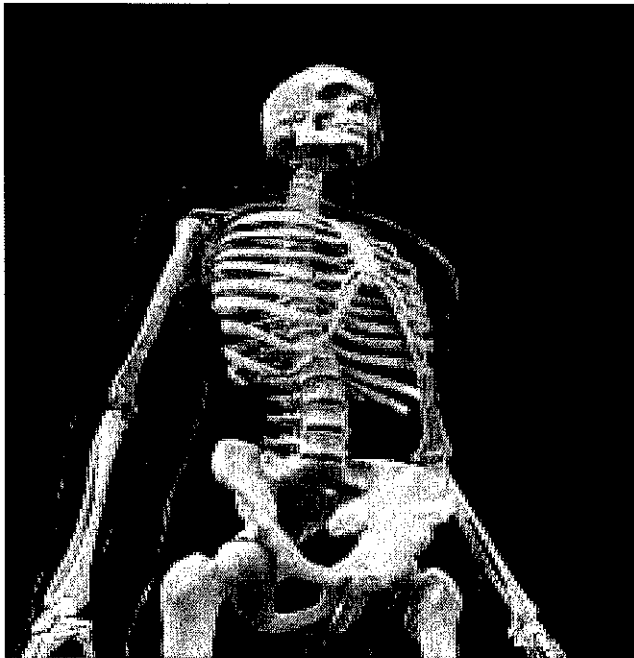
