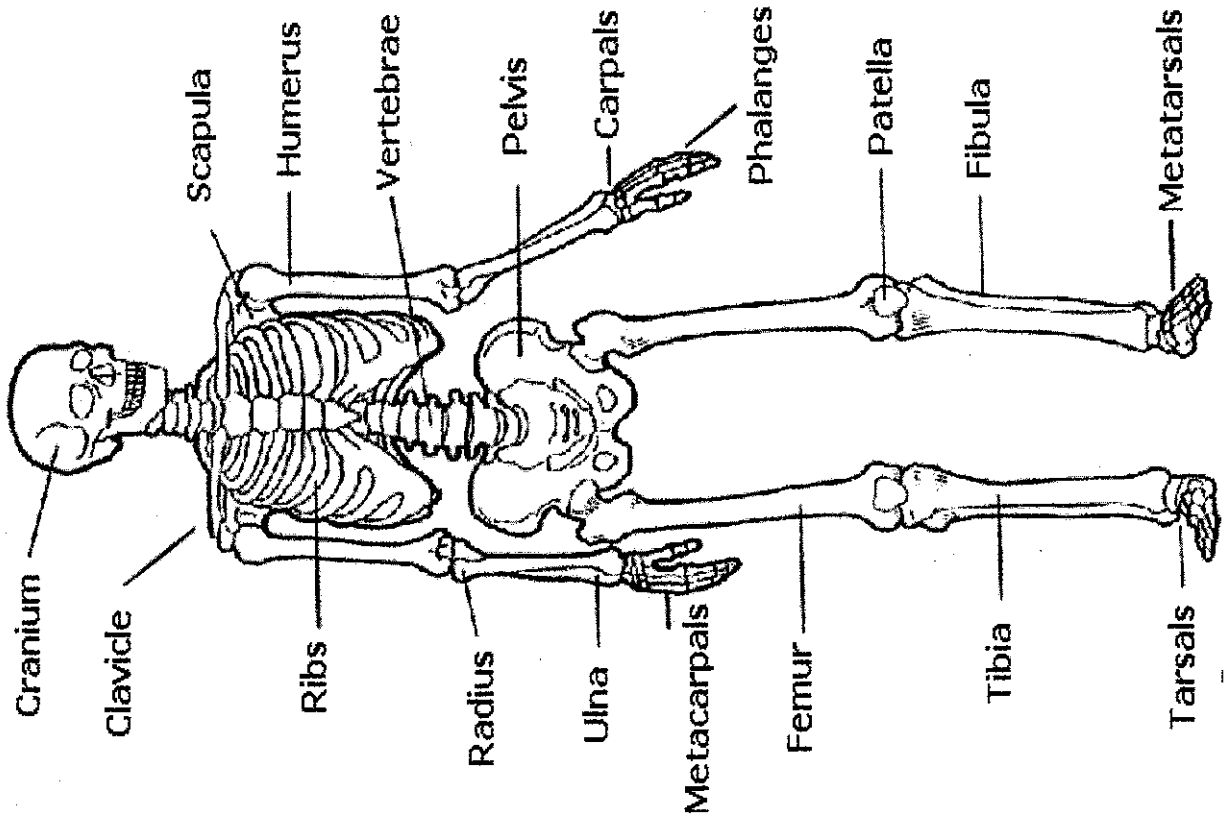

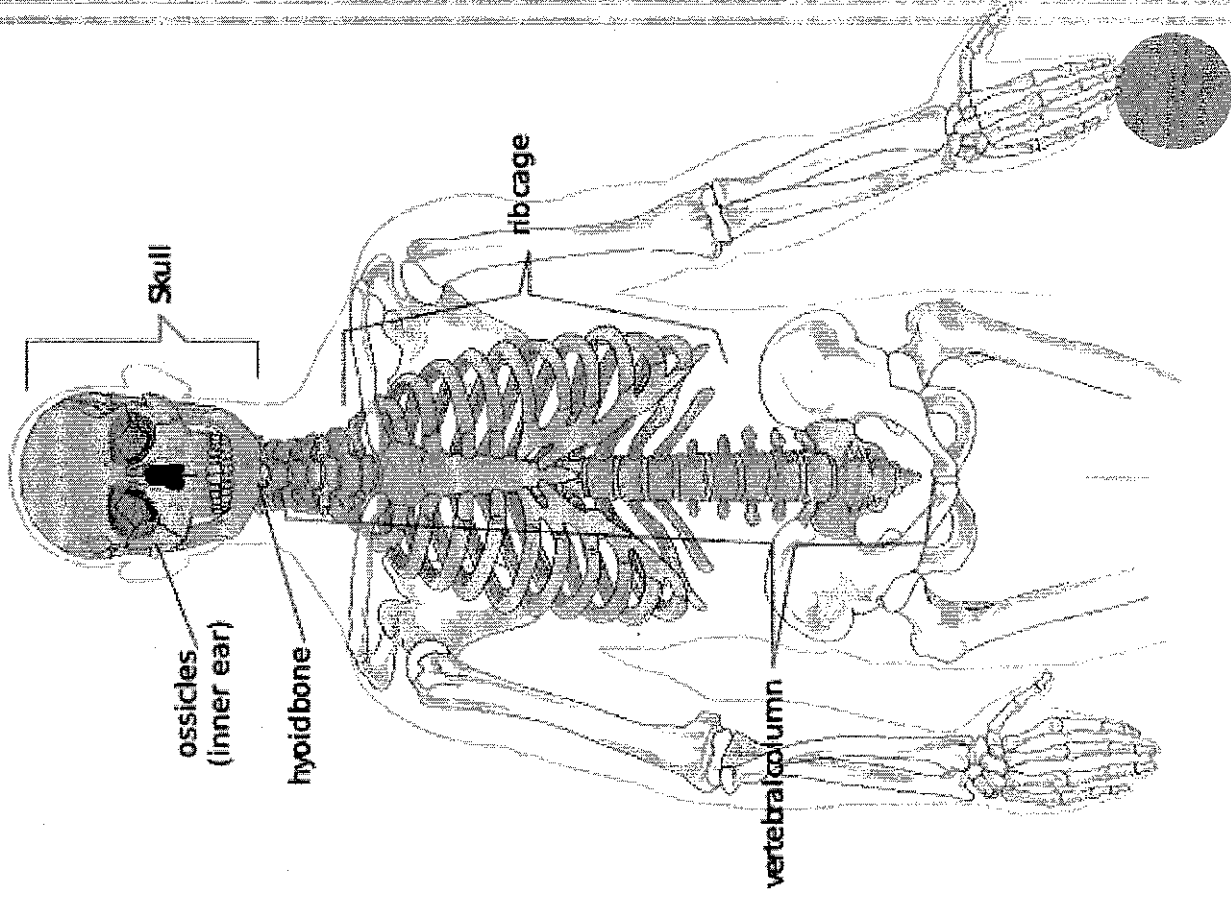


SAY HELLO TO THE SKELETAL SYSTEM 😊

 - Blood Cell Formation-Red & White Blood Cells are made in the Bone Marrow

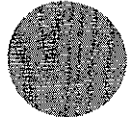
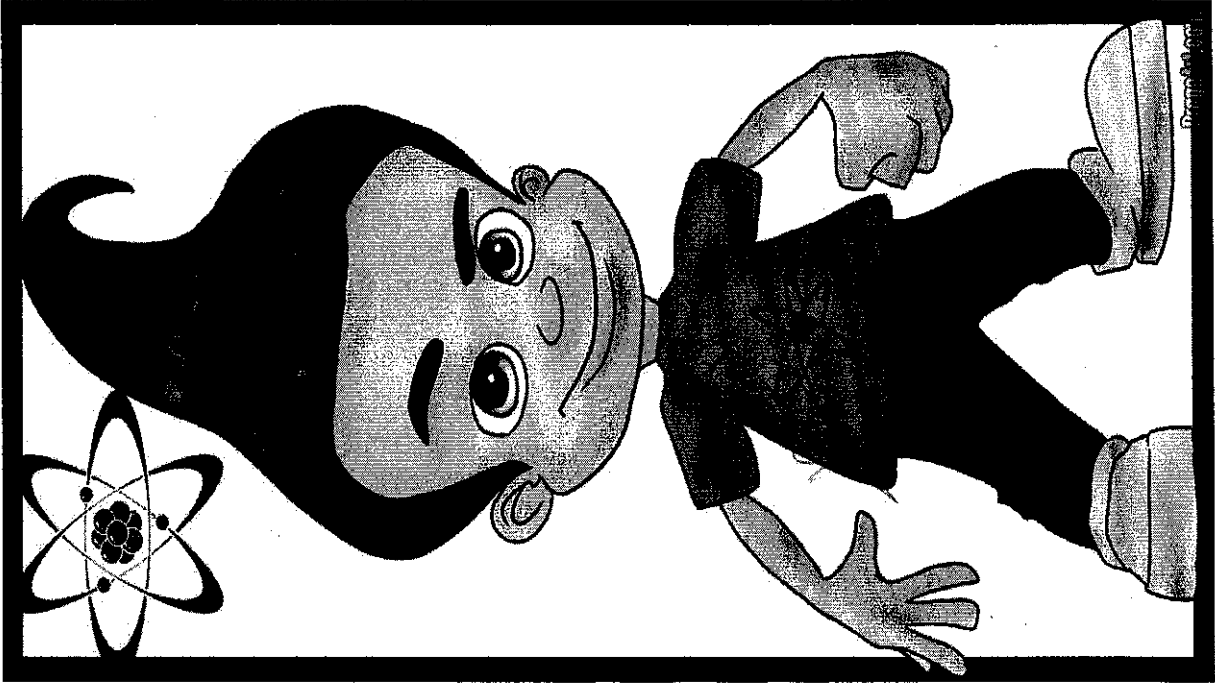
AXIAL SKELETON

- Also, it gives us surface to attach muscles



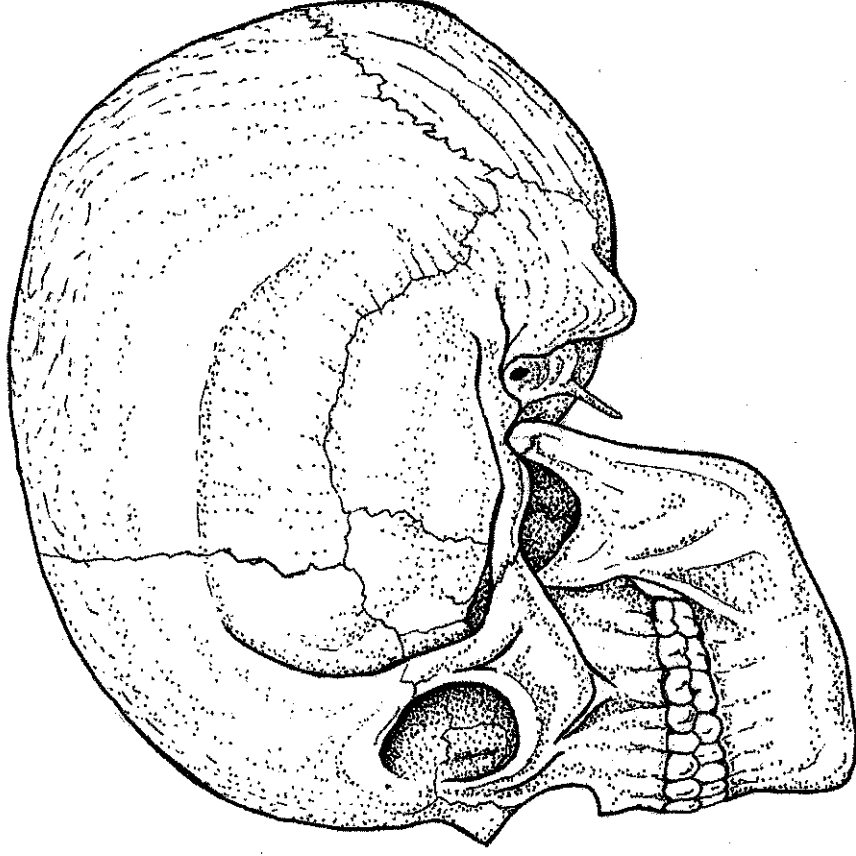
JIMMY

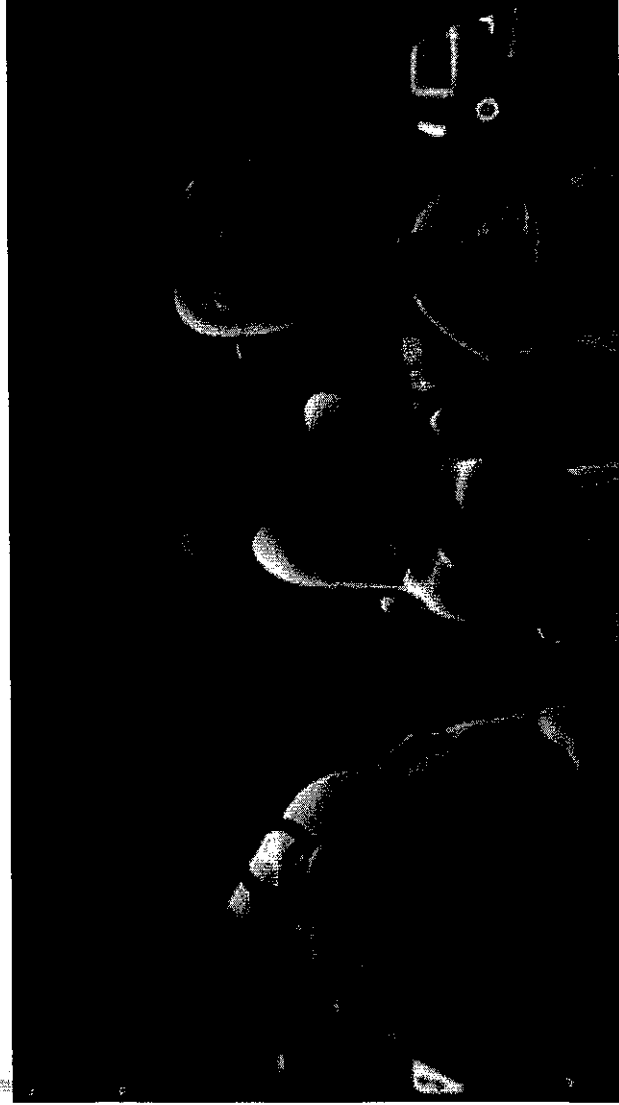
THE SKULL

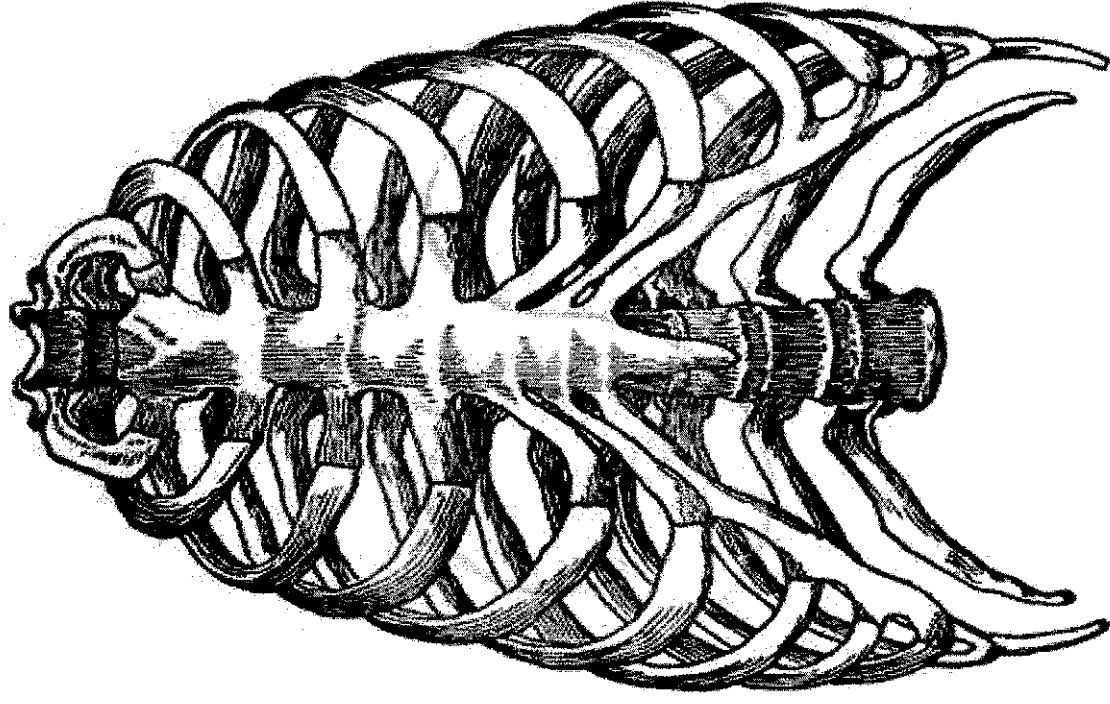
JIMMY BROKE HIS NOSE

RIB CAGE

- Rib Cage = Thoracic Cage
- The Thoracic Cage consist of the Costal Cartilage (connects the sternum & ends of ribs), Sternum (Breastbone), True Ribs (1-7: Joined at the sternum), False Ribs (8-10: Joined at the breastbone), Floating Ribs (11-12: Not connected to anything at all, Connected to the Diaphragm



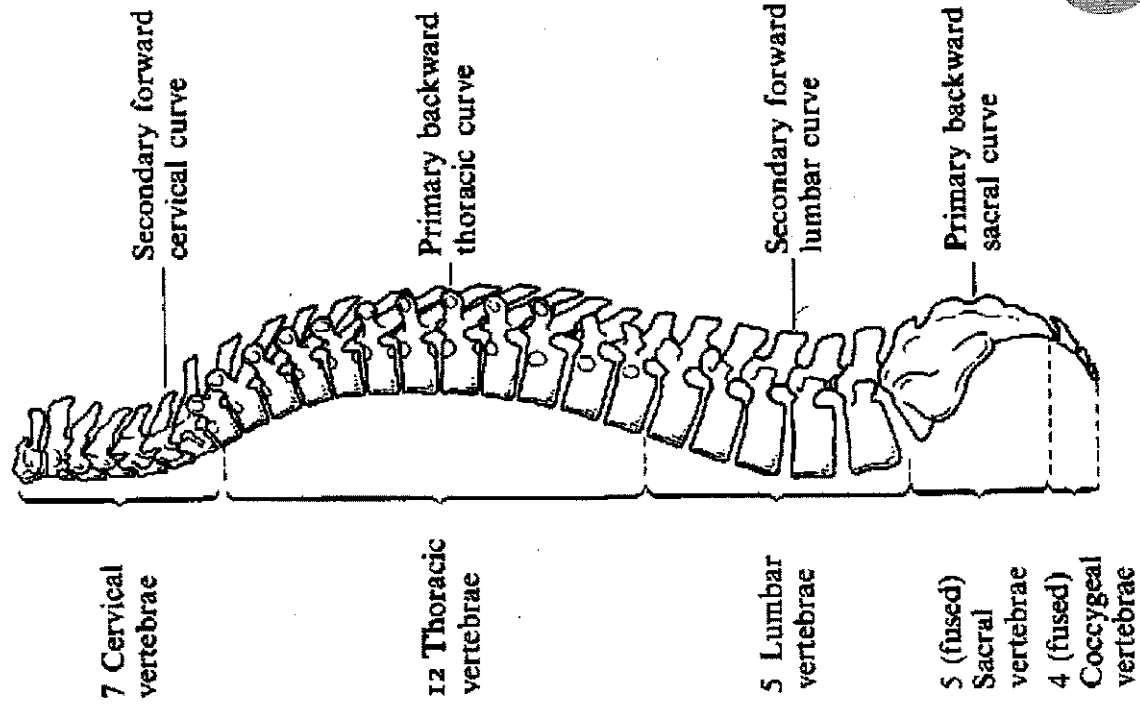
JIMMY CRACKED HIS TRUE RIBS (1-7)

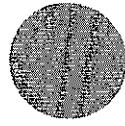
SPINAL CORD

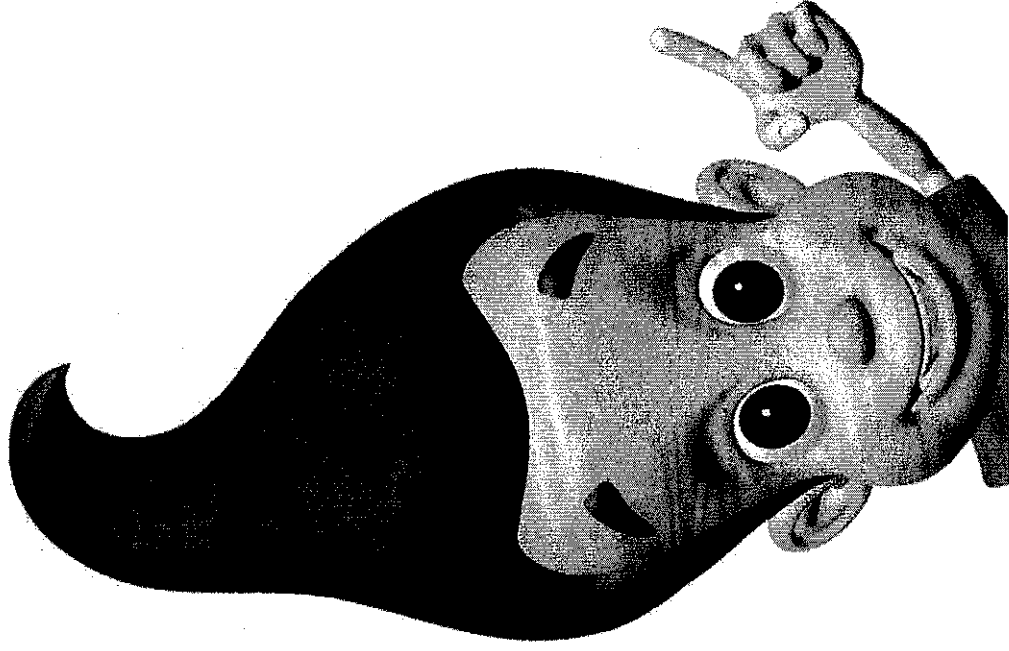
SUMMARY OF BOOK & BIO OF AUTHOR
